- Teal Mosaic Pieces
- Grey Mosaic Pieces
- Pink Mosaic Pieces
- Dark Teal Acrylic Paint
- Grout
- Glue
- Paint Brush



## Boho Coaster Set Kit

## Instructions

**Step 1:** On one of the ceramic coasters glue a stripe of the Teal Mosaic Pieces on the edge of the coaster. Use just a dab of glue on the back of the mosaic piece (a little goes a long way). Allow a small amount of space in between each of the pieces for grouting. Be sure to align the mosaic pieces flush with the edge of the coaster. You do not want any mosaic pieces hanging over the edge.

**Step 2:** Repeat the steps above using the Pink Mosaic Pieces, then the Grey Mosaic Pieces creating an alternating striped pattern covering the entire coaster.

**Step 3:** Next repeat the following steps to cover the rest of the coasters with the mosaic pieces. Feel free to create your own alternating color patterns on each tile to mix it up and give your coasters a fun and funky look! Once all of the coasters are covered, let the glue dry.

**Step 4: Grouting Instructions:** Pour grout into a disposable cup. Use a disposable spoon to mix in small amounts of water until the grout is a peanut butter consistency. Spread the grout mixture over the coaster's surface, letting the grout fill in all the spaces between the mosaic pieces. Allow the grout to set for 15-30 minutes, then wipe off the excess grout with a paper towel. (Once the grout is completely dry in about 24 hours, you can use a damp sponge or cloth to polish all of the mosaic pieces).

**Step 5:** Once grout is dry, paint the back and edges of all the coasters with 2 coats of Dark Teal Acrylic Paint. Let dry and enjoy!

## Instructions

**Step 1:** On one of the ceramic coasters glue a stripe of the Teal Mosaic Pieces on the edge of the coaster. Use just a dab of glue on the back of the mosaic piece (a little goes a long way). Allow a small amount of space in between each of the pieces for grouting. Be sure to align the mosaic pieces flush with the edge of the coaster. You do not want any mosaic pieces hanging over the edge.

**Step 2:** Repeat the steps above using the Pink Mosaic Pieces, then the Grey Mosaic Pieces creating an alternating striped pattern covering the entire coaster.

**Step 3:** Next repeat the following steps to cover the rest of the coasters with the mosaic pieces. Feel free to create your own alternating color patterns on each tile to mix it up and give your coasters a fun and funky look! Once all of the coasters are covered, let the glue dry.

**Step 4: Grouting Instructions:** Pour grout into a disposable cup. Use a disposable spoon to mix in small amounts of water until the grout is a peanut butter consistency. Spread the grout mixture over the coaster's surface, letting the grout fill in all the spaces between the mosaic pieces. **Step 5:** Once grout is dry, paint the back and edges of all the coasters with 2 coats of Dark Teal Acrylic Paint. Let dry and enjoy!
