



Pencil Caddy Kit

Materials Included:

- Ceramic Golf Bag Utensil Holder
- Yellow Acrylic Paint
- Blue Acrylic Paint
- Brown Acrylic Paint
- Green Acrylic Paint
- Dark Green Acrylic Paint
- Black Acrylic Paint
- Paint Brush

Instructions

- Step 1:** Paint all of the zipper pouches and back strap on the Ceramic Golf Bag Utensil Holder with 2 coats of Green Acrylic Paint. Let dry (should only take a few minutes).
- Step 2:** Next paint 3-4 evenly spaced vertical stripes on all of the pouches on the bag with Dark Green Acrylic Paint. Then paint the same amount of horizontal stripes using the Dark Green Acrylic paint on the same areas. You may only be able to fit 2-3 vertical/horizontal stripes on the smaller pouch. This will create a grid pattern on all of the pouches. Let dry.
- Step 3:** On the back strap, paint 1 vertical stripe with Dark Green Acrylic Paint, and 3 horizontal stripes. Let dry.
- Step 4:** Using the Blue Acrylic Paint, add in some thin vertical stripes in between the Dark Green ones that were painted on all of the areas. Then add in thin horizontal stripes in between as well. Now you should have a Blue grid pattern over the Dark Green grid pattern. Let dry.
- Step 5:** Next take the Yellow Acrylic paint and add thin lines over top of all of the Dark Green vertical/horizontal lines. Make sure they are thin so you can still see the Dark Green lines. Overall you should now have a plaid pattern with Dark Green, Blue, Yellow lines. Let dry.
- Step 6:** Paint 2 coats of Brown Acrylic Paint on all of the unpainted areas on the inside, outside, and bottom of the Golf Bag. Let dry.
- Step 7:** Once all of the paint is totally dry, use the Black Acrylic Paint and outline all of the pouches, zipper pulls, straps, and tassels. On the back of the Golf Bag there are rings that hold the straps on, paint those all black.
- Step 8:** Outline the top and bottom of the Golf Bag with black. Then add 2 black dots inside of all the zipper pulls.
- Step 9:** Let your Ceramic Golf Bag Utensil Holder dry completely and enjoy!



Pencil Caddy Kit

Materials Included:

- Ceramic Golf Bag Utensil Holder

- Blue Acrylic Paint

Instructions

- Step 1:** Paint all of the zipper pouches and back strap on the Ceramic Golf Bag Utensil Holder with 2 coats of Green Acrylic Paint. Let dry (should only take a few minutes).
- Step 2:** Next paint 3-4 evenly spaced vertical stripes on all of the pouches on the bag with Dark Green Acrylic Paint. Then paint the same amount of horizontal stripes using the Dark Green Acrylic paint on the same areas. You may only be able to fit 2-3 vertical/horizontal stripes on the smaller pouch. This will create a grid pattern on all of the pouches. Let dry.
- Step 3:** On the back strap, paint 1 vertical stripe with Dark Green Acrylic Paint, and 3 horizontal stripes. Let dry.
- Step 4:** Using the Blue Acrylic Paint, add in some thin vertical stripes in between the Dark Green ones that were painted on all of the areas. Then add in thin horizontal stripes in between as well. Now you should have a Blue grid pattern over the Dark Green grid pattern. Let dry.
- Step 5:** Next take the Yellow Acrylic paint and add thin lines over top of all of the Dark Green vertical/horizontal lines. Make sure they are thin so you can still see the Dark Green lines. Overall you should now have a plaid pattern with Dark Green, Blue, Yellow lines. Let dry.
- Step 6:** Paint 2 coats of Brown Acrylic Paint on all of the unpainted areas on the inside, outside, and bottom of the Golf Bag. Let dry.
- Step 7:** Once all of the paint is totally dry, use the Black Acrylic Paint and outline all of the pouches, zipper pulls, straps, and tassels. On the back of the Golf Bag there are rings that hold the straps on, paint those all black.
- Step 8:** Outline the top and bottom of the Golf Bag with black. Then add 2 black dots inside of all the zipper pulls.
- Step 9:** Let your Ceramic Golf Bag Utensil Holder dry completely and enjoy!
