



Mosaic Wine Bottle Kit

Materials Included:

- Wine Bottle Plaque
- Green Mosaic Pieces
- Purple Mosaic Pieces
- Purple Iridescent Mosaic Pieces
- Clear Round Mosaic Pieces
- Glue
- Grout
- Purple Acrylic Paint
- Paint Brush

Instructions

- Step 1:** Take the Clear Round Mosaic Pieces and flip them over to where the flat side is facing up.
- Step 2:** Use the Purple Acrylic Paint and paint 2 coats on the flat sides of all of the Clear Round Mosaic pieces. Let dry (should only take a few minutes).
- Step 3:** Once the Clear Round Mosaic Pieces are dry, glue these in the center of the Wine Bottle Plaque in the shape of grapes. (Refer to the picture on the left.) A little glue goes a long way so only use a dab on the back of each mosaic piece. Make sure to leave a small amount of space in between the mosaic pieces for grout.
- Step 4:** Next take 4 of the Green Mosaic Pieces and glue them to the top left side of the grapes in the shape of a leaf. Make sure to align the pieces flush with the edge of the plaque. You do not want any pieces hanging over.
- Step 5:** Then fill in the area around the grapes and leaf using the Purple Mosaic Pieces. Make sure to leave about an inch of space at the bottom of the bottle, and the neck of the bottle blank. (Refer to the picture on the left.)
- Step 6:** Glue the Purple Iridescent Mosaic Pieces on the neck of the bottle. Refer to the picture on the left on how to position these pieces to fit the best. Then glue the Purple Iridescent Mosaic Pieces on the bottom of the bottle. Let glue dry completely. (10-15 minutes)
- Step 7:** Grouting Instructions: Pour grout into a disposable cup. Use a disposable spoon to mix in small amounts of water until the grout is a peanut butter consistency. Spread the grout mixture over the wine bottle's surface, letting the grout fill in all the spaces between the mosaic pieces. Allow the grout to set for 15-30 minutes, then wipe off the excess grout with a paper towel. Be sure to wipe off the edges of the plaque. (Once the grout is completely dry in about 24 hours, you can use a damp sponge or cloth to polish all of the mosaic pieces.)
- Step 8:** Once grout is dry, paint the edge of the Wine Bottle with 2 coats of Purple Acrylic Paint. Let paint dry completely and enjoy!



Mosaic Wine Bottle Kit

Materials Included:

- Wine Bottle Plaque
- Green Mosaic Pieces
- Purple Mosaic Pieces
- Purple Iridescent Mosaic Pieces
- Clear Round Mosaic Pieces
- Glue
- Grout
- Purple Acrylic Paint
- Paint Brush

Instructions

- Step 1:** Take the Clear Round Mosaic Pieces and flip them over to where the flat side is facing up.
- Step 2:** Use the Purple Acrylic Paint and paint 2 coats on the flat sides of all of the Clear Round Mosaic pieces. Let dry (should only take a few minutes).
- Step 3:** Once the Clear Round Mosaic Pieces are dry, glue these in the center of the Wine Bottle Plaque in the shape of grapes. (Refer to the picture on the left.) A little glue goes a long way so only use a dab on the back of each mosaic piece. Make sure to leave a small amount of space in between the mosaic pieces for grout.
- Step 4:** Next take 4 of the Green Mosaic Pieces and glue them to the top left side of the grapes in the shape of a leaf. Make sure to align the pieces flush with the edge of the plaque. You do not want any pieces hanging over.
- Step 5:** Then fill in the area around the grapes and leaf using the Purple Mosaic Pieces. Make sure to leave about an inch of space at the bottom of the bottle, and the neck of the bottle blank. (Refer to the picture on the left.)
- Step 6:** Glue the Purple Iridescent Mosaic Pieces on the neck of the bottle. Refer to the picture on the left on how to position these pieces to fit the best. Then glue the Purple Iridescent Mosaic Pieces on the bottom of the bottle. Let glue dry completely. (10-15 minutes)
- Step 7:** Grouting Instructions: Pour grout into a disposable cup. Use a disposable spoon to mix in small amounts of water until the grout is a peanut butter consistency. Spread the grout mixture over the wine bottle's surface, letting the grout fill in all the spaces between the mosaic pieces. Allow the grout to set for 15-30 minutes, then wipe off the excess grout with a paper towel. Be sure to wipe off the edges of the plaque. (Once the grout is completely dry in about 24 hours, you can use a damp sponge or cloth to polish all of the mosaic pieces.)
- Step 8:** Once grout is dry, paint the edge of the Wine Bottle with 2 coats of Purple Acrylic Paint. Let paint dry completely and enjoy!
