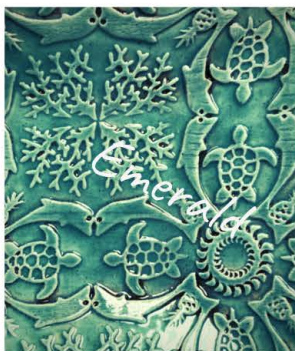


# TERRA BELLA

Apply these glazes over or under the other Terra Bella colors to enhance and create beautiful and moving effects.

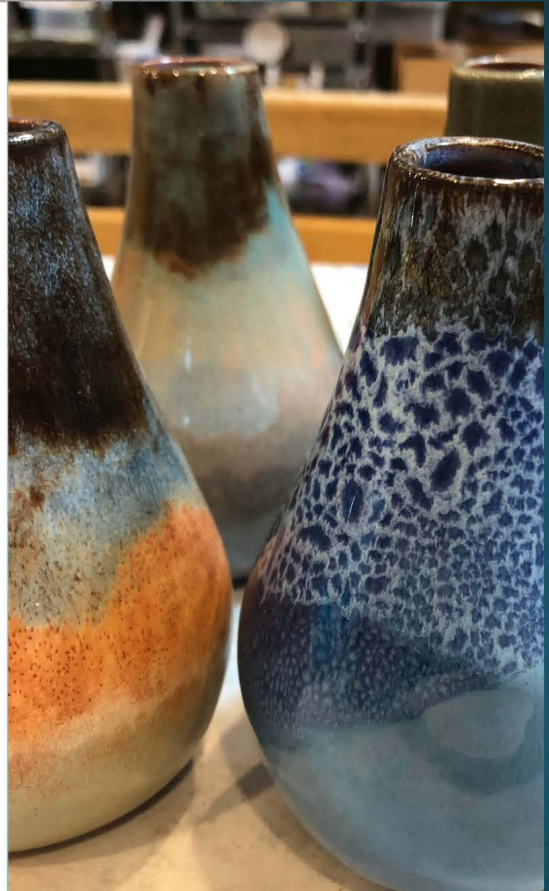

## Terra Bella Glazes

Terra Bella specialty Glazes replicate the high fire pottery look with low fire temperature cone 06. Each of these colors fire to a unique effect. Some are multi-tone with satin shine, while others fire to a high gloss shine and then some have speckles. Endless color combinations can be achieved layering these glazes!

There are 4 unique glazes (HSC 550, 575, 576, 577) in this line which are created to enhance, change, react or create fun effects over or under the rest of the Terra Bella glazes. 1-2 coats only.

- Rustic Brown #550 creates weathered look on rims and works great on texture pieces.
- Spruce, Emerald and Seaweed move and flow creating beautiful drips and surprising effects! 1-2 coats only. Great for Christmas Trees!!!



Layer these glazes for unique colors and effects.

We suggest painting color charts to see the different combinations and results.

Paint 2 coat vertical stripes with all the different colors and then paint 2 coats horizontal stripes of the same colors over the vertical stripes, (make sure to write the numbers). You will see how the colors react with the layering of the different colors.

High Gloss Colors: HSC 551, 552, 553, 554, 558, 562, 563, 564, 565, 566, 567, 568, 569, 570, 574

Matte/Satin Colors: HSC 555, 556, 557, 559, 571, 572, 573, 578

Enhancing/Aventurina Colors: HSC 550, 575, 576, 577. 1-2 coats only. (See other side for details)

- Mix well
- Apply 2 to 3 coats (with the exception of the enhancing colors or the Aventurinas)
- Use on low-fire clay bodies only.
- Fire to cone 06
- These glazes will appear different depending on the thickness of application.
- Terra Bella Glazes cannot be dipped in clear glaze
- Water cleanup

Terra Bella glazes are non-toxic and safe for Food Containers.

Available in 4 oz. and 1 pint jars.
