

SGRAFFITO FISH DISH



GLAZES

SC002 Melon-Choly

SC097 Cant-elope

SC027 Sour Apple

SC028 Blue Isle

SC032 Bluebeard

MATERIALS

675 Lil' Fish Pet Bowl

C500-F4 Cobalt Fan Brush #4

9599 Hydra Art Sponge

Fish Template (optional)

Pencil

Scissors

Toothpick or Wooden Skewer



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe down the fish bowl with a slightly damp Hydra Art Sponge.
2. Take a pencil and lightly divide the fish plate into 4 sections going down the body.
3. Use a fan brush and paint 1-2 solid coats of Melon-Choly on the head.
4. Paint 1-2 solid coats of Cant-elope in the next section.
5. Use a clean, damp brush to blend the line where the colors meet.
6. Repeat steps 3-5 filling in the last two sections of the fish with Sour Apple and Blue Isle.
7. Let the glazes dry until they have lost their sheen.
8. Use long, even strokes to paint 2 thick coats of Bluebeard over the entire fish.
9. Cut out the fish template while you wait for the Bluebeard to dry to the touch.
10. Once the Bluebeard is dry to the touch, place the template in the dish. Use pressure to lightly trace the design with a dull pencil. This will leave an indentation in the glaze.
11. Remove the template and use a toothpick or wooden skewer to gently carve through the Bluebeard along the indentations and expose the colors underneath. Be careful not to apply too much pressure, or you will carve through the color rather than revealing it.
12. After carving, let the piece dry completely, then use a dry brush to gently sweep off the dried glaze scrapings.
13. Clear glaze and fire to Cone 06.
